

## GENERAL STANLEY MCCHRYSTAL



GEN (ret) Stan McChrystal is the CEO and founder of the McChrystal Group. He founded McChrystal Group in January 2011 to deliver innovative leadership solutions to businesses globally in order to help them transform and succeed in challenging, dynamic environments. As Founder and a Partner, he advises senior executives at multinational corporations on navigating complex change and building stronger teams.

He is a retired United States Army general best known for his command of Joint Special Operations Command in the mid-2000s. His last assignment was as Commander, International Security Assistance Force and Commander, United States Forces - Afghanistan. He held the post from June 15, 2009 to June 23, 2010. He previously served as Director, Joint Staff from August 2008 to June 2009 and as Commander of JSOC from 2003 to 2008 and throughout his career served in a variety of leadership and direct action roles in the U.S. Army Ranger and Special Operations Community.

GEN (ret) McChrystal has served on a number of public company boards to include JetBlue; Navistar International; and Siemens. He is also the author of three best New York Times and Amazon best selling books on leadership and his personal biography: *Team of Teams*; *Leaders*; and *My Share of The Task*.

GEN (ret) McChrystal earned a B.S. degree from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1976 and subsequently an M.S. Degree from the US Naval War College, an M.S. Degree from Salve Regina University, and completed fellowships at Harvard's John F. Kennedy School of Government in 1997 and at the Council on Foreign Relations in 2000.
